Are you willing to admit that you are part of a truly "foolish" family? It is not without the "foolish factor" that Jesus Christ is also known as the "Son of David."

God's prophets routinely made "fools" of themselves.

The Pharisee Saul of Taurus became Paul the Apostle.

Throughout the two thousand one hundred years of Christianity the faithful have stepped forward form the safety of anonymity or the security of a wellheeled position to embrace foolishness.

During this Easter season and all year take a risk at caring about someone who is truly risky.
