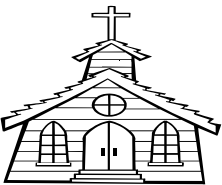

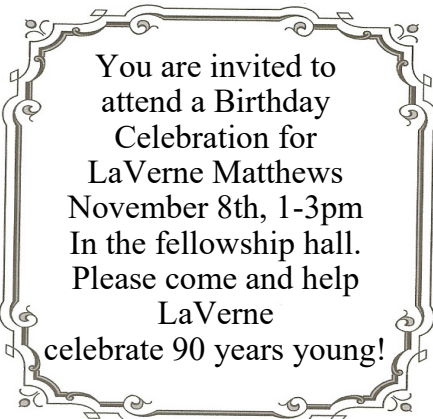

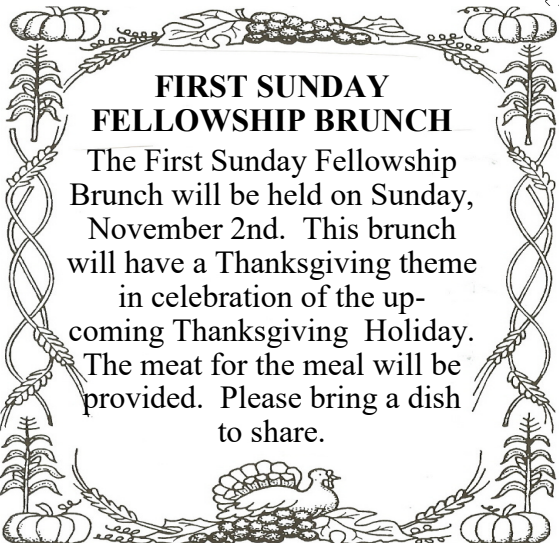

Every recipe has its essential ingredients—the things that define its flavor and make it what it is. Over the past several weeks, we’ve been talking about the ingredients that make up a healthy church. Not programs or buildings, but the spiritual ingredients that shape our identity as the people of God: The Grace of God, The Word of God, The Spirit of God, The People of God, The Hope of God and The Love of God

These are not just topics for a sermon series; they are the marks of who we are and who we’re becoming together. When these ingredients are mixed in the right proportions—grace poured over truth, hope stirred with love, and the Spirit binding us together—the result is something only God can make: a living, breathing church that looks like Jesus.

The pastor and author Brennan Manning once wrote, “*The Church is not a museum for saints, but a hospital for sinners.*” That’s a powerful reminder that the Church exists not for the perfect, but for the broken. We are a community of grace for those who know they need it most. Every person who walks through our doors is a soul loved by God, a life in need of His healing touch—and every one of us has a part to play in showing that love.

So, what does it look like for the First Christian Church family, to live out these ingredients? It looks like grace extended to one another when it would be easier to judge. It looks like people rooted in the Word, led by the Spirit, filled with hope, and overflowing with love. It looks like a church that refuses to turn inward but opens its arms outward—because that’s exactly what Jesus did. Let’s keep building together on these foundations. Let’s be a church where grace is tasted, truth is taught, and love is lived.

The recipe for a faithful church has never changed—it’s Jesus, working through His people for the sake of the world.
